In 2006 the Rotary Club of Stratford honored him with the Paul Harris Fellow, the highest recognition for a Rotarian.

Brother Aroutzidis is a member of the Holy Trinity Greek Orthodox Church in London, Ontario where he has served on several committees over the years. At present Nick resides in Stratford, Ontario with his wife Virginia (formerly Virginia Sinioris) and their children Mary-Ellen, Haritos and Vlasis.
