### **NEW AHEPA SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

The AHEPA scholarship program in Manitoba in 2008 is increased from **\$4000** for 4 scholarships to **\$9500** for 6 scholarships. Thanks to the generosity of Paul Kostas (\$5500), Demetrios and Helene Kontzamanis (\$1500) and the George Kalaitzakis family (\$1500), AHEPA offers 6 scholarships in 2008. AHEPA Scholarships sponsored by Paul Kostas are named after philosopher Kleovoulos of Rhodes, one of the 7 sages or wise men of Ancient Hellas. «**Παν μέτρον ἄριστον**» or “**Everything is best in moderation**” is one of his famous sayings. Please check scholarship applications for full details. The names of the scholarship recipients will be announced at the Banquet commemorating October 28<sup>th</sup>1940 which is organized by AHEPA in Winnipeg. Many thanks to Tom Argyriou for donating \$50 per year towards the scholarships for so many years and to all those who have contributed funds or volunteer work which has built-up and sustained the AHEPA Scholarship Fund since 1990. **It is worth mentioning that between 1990 and 2007, Winnipeg AHEPA has awarded 52 scholarships worth a total of \$53,000 to our students.**

All AHEPA Scholarships are open to any member of an AHEPA Family Chapter in Manitoba. The **Kleovoulos Scholarship for Hellenic Studies, worth \$2500** is available to students who are registered in a Manitoba University and have completed a minimum number of credit hours in Hellenic Studies. The **Kleovoulos Scholarship for High School Graduates, worth \$1500**, replaces the Plato Scholarship. Manitoba High School Graduates of Hellenic Heritage or their spouses qualify. The **Kleovoulos Scholarship for AHEPA Family members, worth \$1500**, replaces the Socrates Scholarship and is available to University students. The **Kontzamanis AHEPA Scholarship, worth \$1500** is sponsored by Demetrios and Helene Kontzamanis. Manitobans of Hellenic Heritage or their spouses who have completed at least two years of University qualify. The **Alexander the Great Scholarship, worth \$1500** is available to Manitoba AHEPA Family members or their spouses who are High School Graduates; for 2008 the George Kalaitzakis family is sponsoring this scholarship. The **Penelope Scholarship, worth \$1000**, is sponsored by the Winnipeg Daughters of Penelope Chapter. Manitoba High School Graduates of Hellenic Heritage or their spouses qualify.

In 2008 the Greek Professional Association of Manitoba (GPAM) offers the **Aristotle Scholarship, worth \$1000**. Members of the association and Manitobans of Hellenic Heritage or their spouses who are University students qualify.
